Charlie Martin called the special meeting to order at 1:33 p.m.

1. Roll call.

Noelle Shepard called the roll, and all members were present.

2. Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Discussion on the Town's property and casualty and workers' compensation insurance.

Sean Kimball introduced Scott Sundberg and Dan Anderson from Acrisure. Scott Sundberg explained that Acrisure works with 70 municipalities around CT, and he personally has been in the business for 39 years.

He reviewed what coverages are currently in place. He mentioned that Mark Wantroba from their office does OSHA training and inspections for the Town. Risk is included in the coverage. He explained the claim collection service aspect of the firm. He mentioned that they worked with the Town's Parks and Recreation Department to institute a certificate of insurance program.

Sean Kimball explains that they do regular playground inspections for the Town. Scott Sundberg discussed the Police Accountability Act.

Scott Sundberg explained the impact of the two new school projects on rates. He explained that the State of Connecticut does not have a tort cap, which impacts claims and thereby premiums.

The Insurance Advisory Study Group reviewed the loss information provided by Acrisure.

Discussion was had on budget indications. Scott Sundberg explained that they marketed workers compensation only last year, and they market excess every year. Katie Archer left the meeting at 2:42 p.m.

4. Adjournment.

Jim Gidicscin motioned to adjourn the meeting, and Charlie Martin seconded the motion. All in favor, the motion passed, 2-0. The meeting adjourned at 2:52 p.m.
